



Pre-Trip To Do List

1. Turn on fridge.
2. Check beneath RV for leaks, loose objects, or anything out of the ordinary.
3. Check all fluid levels: oil, coolant, washer fluid, brake fluid, etc.
4. Check each tire:
 - a. Check Tire Pressure and fill according to vehicle load
 - b. Check for unusual tire wear
 - c. Check lug nut torque
5. Check engine starting battery: clean connections, proper state of charge.
6. Make sure all turn signals, running lights, and hazard lights are working.
 - a. (If towing, check lights on towed vehicle as well.)
7. Check horn operation.
8. Verify 12v and 120v Power (generator or inverter).
9. Charge batteries on accessories (Tire Pressure Monitor, walkie talkies, etc.).
10. Check the air intake filters on your air conditioner and clean as necessary.
11. Verify that the fire extinguishers are present and fully charged.
12. Test smoke, carbon monoxide, and propane leak detectors.
13. Ensure kitchen and roof vents function properly.
14. Check operation of waste tank level indicators (start trip on empty).
15. Fill fresh water.
16. Check operation of water heater.
17. Add any needed chemicals (or compost medium) to holding tanks.
18. Make available RV manuals, appliance manuals, etc. (download or print)
19. Fill Propane.
20. Load up and have fun!
